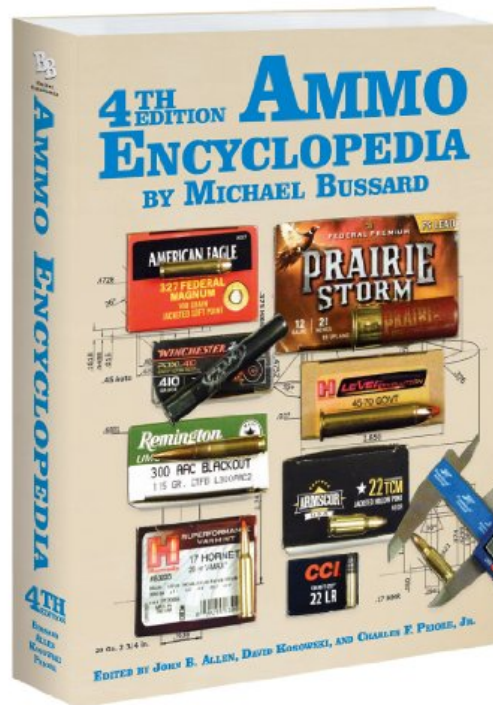

Very complete with vast information on enormous numbers of calibers and the guns that shoot them. I think the organization is too rigorous - grouping calibers in too many sub-categories, so individual cartridges are sometimes difficult to find. Also, I suspect that the write-ups on some calibers contain more information that is generic to their class and less garnered from specific research. But these are minor complaints.
