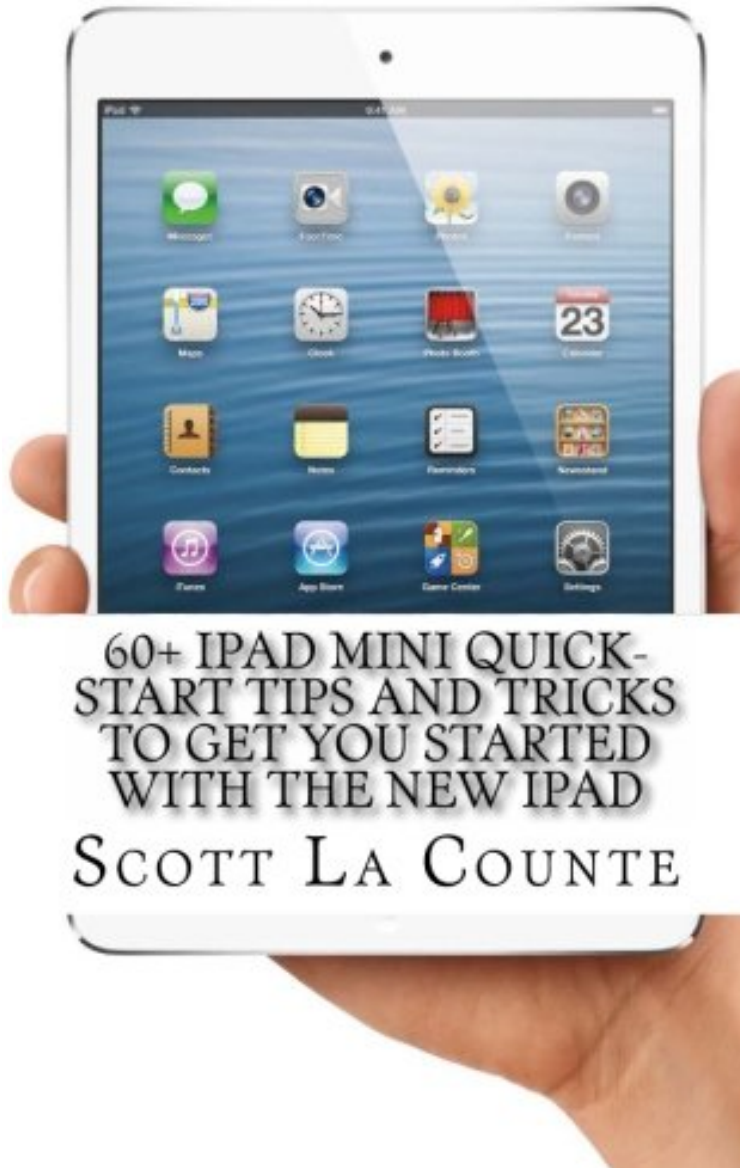

Additionally, if you'd like to just see what significant things have been added to iOS 6 then jump to the last section which is just for your reference and does not count towards the 50+ tips in this short guide. Note: The iPad Mini contains the same features you see on other iPads, so these tips apply across all devices running iOS 6 (aside from Siri, which the iPad 2 is not currently supporting) most also will work with older iPads and the iPhone.
